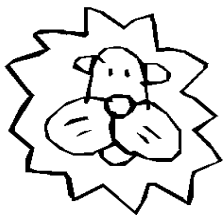

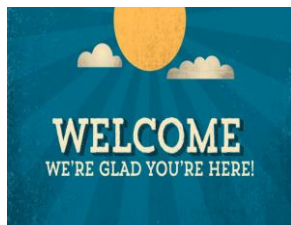


Welcome back everyone to term 4
