

Scenic World Blue Mountains Excursion

A Stage 1 excursion has been booked for Thursday 20th October 2022.

Students descend into the Valley on the Scenic Railway – the world's steepest passenger train. A Scenic World guide will then escort the group along the Walkway via the coal mining exhibits and through the rainforest.

The group will return to the top of the escarpment via the Cableway, with spectacular views of the Three Sisters, Orphan Rock and Katoomba Falls. Please note, during peak times the journey may be reversed – descending via the Cableway and returning via the Railway.

The cost of the excursion including bus hire will be \$50.00.
