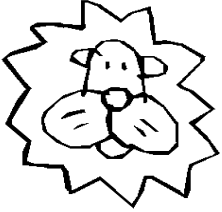

5 DAY SWIMMING and WATER SAFETY PROGRAM



The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival.

Students from **Years 2 and 3** will be eligible to participate in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program regardless of their swimming ability. Instruction will take place at Charlie Lowles Leisure Centre pool, Jersey Road, Emerton. The Program will continue **daily for five days** from **Monday, 4 September** to **Friday, 8 September 2023**. There will be no charge for instruction.

The total cost for the 5 day scheme is \$55. This cost covers entry into the pool each day and bus travel to and from the venue.

They learnt about the yidaki (didgeridoo), tools and weapons, ochre, dance, Indigenous games, and had a go at boomerang throwing.
